Lockdown exemptions list released

Victoria will enter a five-day lockdown from 11.59pm local time tonight following a COVID-19 outbreak. The general indication is that any worker or service that was able to remain operational during Victoria's 2020 lockdown will be able to do so in this five-day period.

Manufacturing operations and facilities have been listed as exempt in the [full table of restrictions](#) as released by the Victorian Premier's office, however each CropLife member company should make its own determination as to the nature of its business in line with the government directives.

The following exempted essential services / workers may be relevant to CropLife members:

- p. a factory or facility that is not able to be shut down without causing damage or loss to plant and equipment, but only those operations that are necessary in order to prevent that damage or loss;
- x. freight services
- ae. primary industries only to the extent necessary to ensure adequate supply of food to, and care of, animals and maintenance of crops.
