Agriculture remains essential as COVID rules change across country

CropLife Australia remains in close contact with Ministerial and Departmental representatives Federally and across states and territories as the COVID-19 situation evolves.

The NSW Department of Premier and Cabinet and NSW Department of Health have confirmed essential services from previous declarations are the same as for this latest lockdown. As such, operations for CropLife Australia members in New South Wales directly related to provision of products and services to farming/agriculture are exempted from the lockdown measures provided there is a COVID-safe plan in place for each specific workplace. Compliance with the general requirements – such as mask wearing – is mandatory.

Across Australia, all individuals previously recognised with essential worker status remain in this classification and therefore are exempt from state/territory border closures. Application prior to crossing is required. Permission to enter a certain state/territory, however, does not automatically mean exemption from isolation on return to home state. Refer to individual state/territory rules on this.

As with previous lockdown orders, where movement can be restricted – even for workers in essential services – it is strongly encouraged.

Should you experience a situation where your operations are impacted, or any state government officials indicate you are not exempted, please notify CropLife immediately so we can coordinate with our dedicated liaison officials.
