Government grants for on-shore manufacturing for critical product

The Federal Government has announced \$50 million available for manufacturing grants as part of the Supply Chain Resilience Initiative.

The grants – which will be matched grants between \$50,000 and \$2,000,000 – are available to those companies that can assist with addressing supply chain vulnerabilities in agricultural chemical products, medicines and PPE production. They are designed to boost specialty manufacturing capability in Australia.

This announcement follows CropLife's advocacy in 2020 to ensure the Federal Government recognised our industry as one that provides critical products in a time of crisis that are essential to Australia's ongoing food security and farming production capability. Agricultural chemicals are just one of three products formally identified by the Federal Government.
