Farmers in all mainland Australian states now free to grow GM crops

Today marks the expiry of the NSW GM crop moratorium, meaning farmers in every mainland state can now access all approved GM crops. This is a great win as it brings Australia's farmers into line with their major international agricultural competitors and will deliver improved productivity and sustainability in farming and provide a boost for crop research and development.

Removing the state moratoria in Western Australia, South Australia and now in New South Wales has been a concerted advocacy effort over many years.
