[COVID-19, state border closures & lockdowns update](#)

As the COVID-19 situation continues to change across the country, CropLife remains in frequent communication with state and territory government departments and ministerial offices to ensure that the essential operations of CropLife members are not unduly interrupted and remain covered by the agricultural industry exemptions. CropLife has secured this undertaking directly and specifically from all state governments that currently have state lockdowns or border closures in place.

Across NSW, VIC and SA, agricultural supply chain exemptions remain in place. Those with essential worker status (which does vary slightly from state-to-state) can continue to leave home for their jobs, provided all COVID protocols are in place.

Should any member companies have difficulty with state government authorities regarding their operations under these exemptions, they should make contact with CropLife so that direct representation can be made with the relevant ministerial offices and departments to address the problems.
