CropLinks: The latest plant science industry news

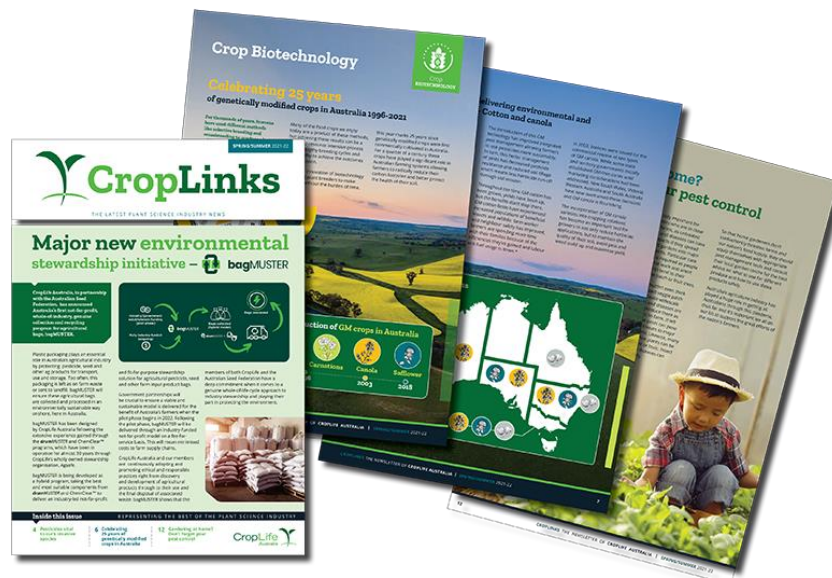
